We have had some recurring issues in school with pupils who have social media out of school either sending or receiving inappropriate messages.

Whilst this is not the responsibility of school – and is actually not our business really – we care about our children and the community and so are always trying to ensure this does not happen.

All our classes receive internet safety lessons as part of their learning on a regular basis.

We alert parents to specific issues on an individual basis and always deal with things as they occur.

However, I strongly suggest that, <u>if your child has a social media account of</u> <u>any type</u>, you set up the parent apps to ensure that you can see any messages coming and going. Also that you check on a regular basis to see what is happening in any groups or chats your child may be in. Whilst you may be sure that your child is not likely to send such messages / content, you do not know about others that may be in that group.

We have also had a couple of occasions where a child has invited someone into a 'chat group' and they have turned out to be an adult. SO please be careful, beware and be internet / social media safe with your children.
