What a fabulous start we have had to the new academic year with our 'Let's Go Wild' project running across school. Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 collaborated to create some amazing wildlife poems, complete with music, movement and drama, in workshops run by Sarah and Abi from the Rotherham Children's Capital of Culture team. Our Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children created some absolutely stunning land art in workshops run by local artist James Brunt. Children in Year 3 and 4 also enjoyed a visit from an owl rescue organisation. In addition to these fabulous workshops, there has been a whole host of activities across school, all with a focus on British wildlife. There has been a real buzz around school and it has been lovely to see our children genuinely excited about nature and keen to make a difference. We will be continuing our focus on doing our bit to protect nature for future generations across the year. Plans include: creating a wildflower area; planting willow arches and walkways; re-lining the pond in the quad for use as a wildlife pond; reinvigorating our quad area (the outside space in the middle of the Junior building) with planting, seating and a bit of re-landscaping; and regenerating our raised beds and planting these up with fruit trees. We have already been contacted by some of our fabulous parents offering help but if you think you could help in any way with any of this work then we would love to hear from you.
