Homework

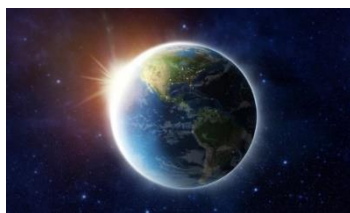
In Year 5, we have high expectations with homework and expect it to be handed in on time and to a high standard. Children in Y5 will be expected to:

- Complete a weekly maths activity, linked to something we have recently covered in class. This will also be handed out/collected in on a Friday.

Below is an overview of what we will be learning this term.

Science	In Science we will be focusing on space and forces. Starting with learning about the different planets, the moon and sun. We will also learn about friction, air and water resistance, as well as levers, gears and pulleys.
History	Children will look at the history of the local area and how and why this has changed throughout time.
Geography	In Geography we will be looking at the local area around Thorpe Hesley and beyond.
Art	In Art we will be focusing on Joe Scarborough's images and using these as inspiration to create our own piece of artwork linked to Rotherham.
ICT	In ICT, we will be learning about online safety. The children will also be learning how to take and upload photographs to a computer.
RE	We will be predominately looking at values within the Christianity religion, with some comparisons to other religions.
PE	In PE we will be focussing on dance and tennis for the first half term, then gymnastics and hockey for the second half term.
PSHE	This term's PSHE focus on friendships and what they mean to us whilst equally considering how to have positive friendships.
Music	We will be using the Charanga music scheme to learn all about pitch, tempo, rhythm, volume and timbre.
DT	In DT during the summer term we will be focusing on researching, designing, making and evaluating our own moon buggies.
Spanish	We will be continuing to learn Spanish during this half term, where we will have opportunities to speak, read and write.
