With all the preparations for Transition for Y6 it could be remiss not to already be planning ahead for future year groups - admission dates for 2025/26 and 2026/27. This year our area has grown again and we have Y6 joining us from schools all over Rotherham, and many from Sheffield, and we can't wait.

Winterhill School, as you know, is a truly inclusive family school in Kimberworth, which reflects the multicultural nature of our local community, area and wider UK.
