Did you know that inkjet and toner cartridges can take up to 1,000 years to decompose in landfill? We have ordered recycling bins to take any cartridges from our school community.


There is a bin in each building and each cartridge will raise money for the school! Please bring in any original or remanufactured inkjet cartridges, and original or remanufactured toner cartridges.
