Yorkshire Water are donating three very special planters to school during the coming months. Situated in the Nursery and Reception outdoor areas and on the Junior yard, our three lovely planters will be examples of innovative Sustainable Urban Drainage, or SUDS. They will take water directly from our downpipes to water the plants and, in the process, slow down the drainage of water into the sewers which will help during times of heavy rainfall and flooding. Here are some examples of the types of planters that are available (although not necessarily the exact ones that we will be donated). One of them will have an interactive educational instillation like the cascade shown here. Not only this but they will plant the containers up for us with some lovely flowers as well.
