This term we will be learning... All about me and my family

Area of Learning	Objectives to be covered
Communication and Language	<p>Listen to simple stories and understand what is happening with the use of pictures (0-3)</p> <p>Copy what adults do, taking 'turns' in conversations (through babbling) and activities. (0-3)</p>
Personal, Social and Emotional	<p>Find ways to calm themselves, through being calmed and comforted by their key person. (PSED 0-3 Yrs)</p> <p>Express preferences and decisions (0-3)</p>
Physical	<p>Explore difference materials and tools (0-3)</p> <p>Build independently with a range of appropriate resources. (PD 0-3 Yrs)</p>
Literacy	<p>Join in with songs and rhymes, copying sounds, rhythms, tunes and tempo. (Lit 0-3 Yrs)</p> <p>Make marks on their picture to stand for their name (0-3 Yrs)</p>
Maths	<p>Take part in finger rhymes with numbers. (Maths 0-3 Yrs)</p> <p>Count in everyday contexts, sometimes skipping numbers 1,2,3,5 (0-3)</p>
Understanding the World	<p>Make connections between the features of their family and other families (0-3)</p>
Expressive Arts and Design	<p>Join in with songs and rhymes and makes some sounds</p> <p>Explore different materials, using all their senses to investigate them (0-3)</p>
