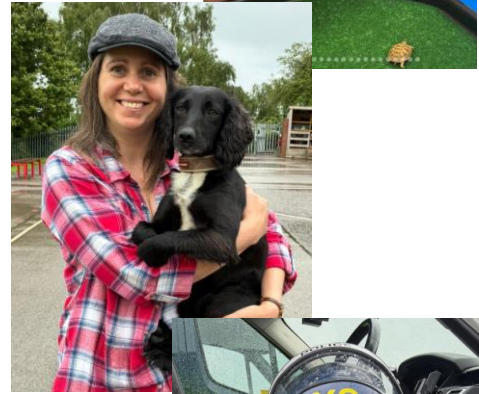


Next week's menu is week 3

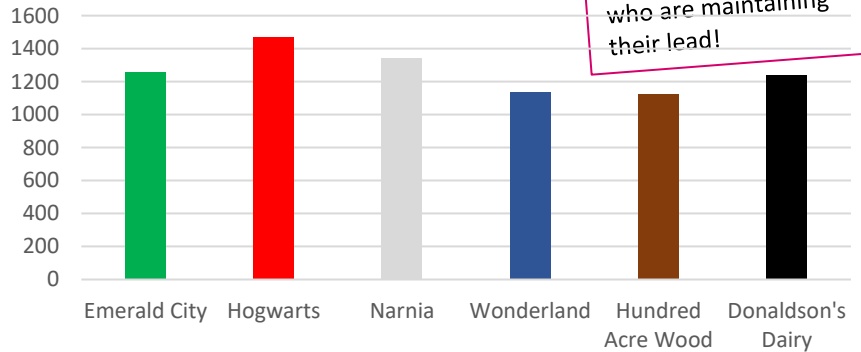
Musical Extravaganza
