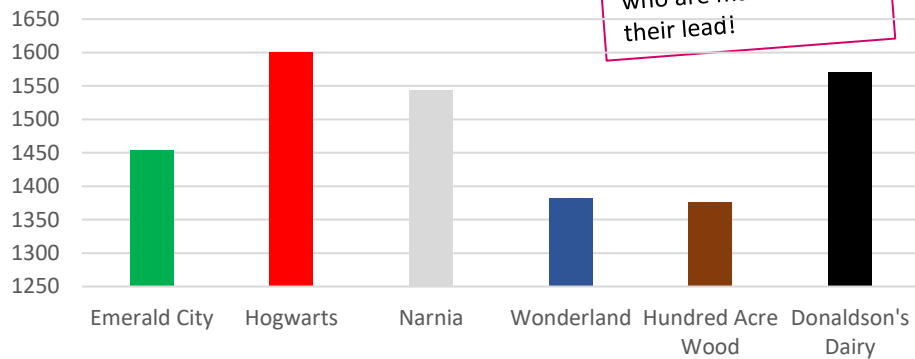
The following classes have achieved 100% Reading this week:
