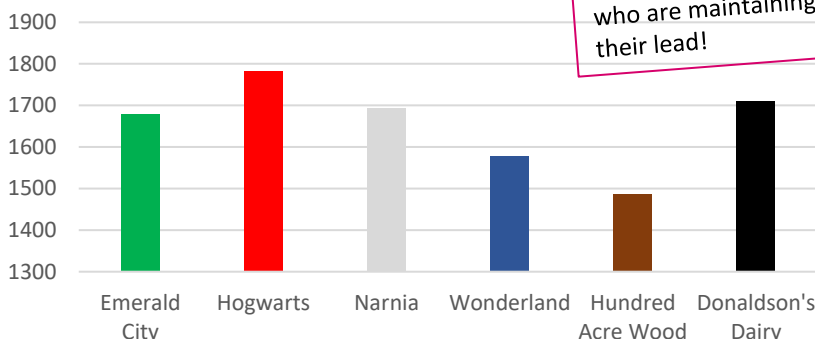
Important Changes to Free School Meals
